

PRIVACY POLICY

Introduction

Welcome to our Privacy Policy (“**policy**”). Thank you for your time to read it.

This policy explains how we collect, use, and protect your Personally Identifiable Information (“**PI**”) that you provide to us when you visit one of our websites, or when you use our Services. It also explains the specific ways we use and disclose that information. We take your privacy extremely seriously, and we never sell lists or email addresses. By visiting the website, you are accepting the practices described in this Policy.

The Basics

This Privacy Policy applies to the websites located at www.scc.world, www.laszloerika.hu, www.tudatoskommunikacio.hu, as well as any other sites or mobile applications owned or operated by us (each a “Website” and together the “Websites”). The “Websites” include the Websites themselves, and any web pages, interactive features, applications, widgets, blogs, social networks, social network “tabs,” or other online, mobile, or wireless offerings that post a link to this Privacy Policy, whether accessed via computer, mobile device, or other technology, manner or means.

The Websites are provided to you by Szuperc Limited a Hongkong based limited company, and shall hereinafter be referred to as “**Szuperc Ltd**” and as “**our**”, “**us**” and “**we**”.

This Policy is a legally binding agreement between Szuperc Limited, and you, an end user, (Member/Subscriber) of our Website and any products and services offered thereby, referred to as and also “**you**”, “**your(s)**” or “**yourself**”).

This Policy shall also include our Terms and Conditions of Service (the “**Terms**”), along with any supplemental guidelines and policies provided by us from time to time, all incorporated herein by reference.

We will never spam your inbox, provide unsolicited offers or otherwise disclose your PI to any third party, unless we have your prior express consent. We work hard to earn and keep your trust; and therefore we adhere to the following principles in order to protect your privacy:

- We are committed to respecting your privacy.
- We will not sell or lease your PI to third parties.
- We will not disclose your PI with other users or third parties without your consent.
- Any PI that you provide to us will be secured with industry standard safety protocols and technology.

As used herein and elsewhere, the words “**use**”, “**collect**”, “**process**”, “**disclose**”, “**treat**” and analogous shall be related to your PI and other data that we may receive from our clients, users and/or visitors, including cookies inside a computer and mobile device IDs.

Information We Collect

In order to use the Website, you may need to disclose certain PI to us, including but not limited to: name, last name, address, mobile phone number, IP address, email, mobile device ID (e.g. Apple IDFA, Android Advertising ID), mobile device type, browser type, language and/or operating system used.

You represent and warrant that you have any and all rights, licenses, authorizations and clearances required for any and all PI that you submit to us, including any releases for the use of their personal image, voice and likeness. If you knowingly misrepresent that such material not is infringing, you may be subject to criminal prosecution for perjury and civil penalties, including monetary damages, court costs, and attorney’s fees.

If you do not wish to disclose any PI to us, you may still be able to use some of the functionalities of the Website, though we will not be able to guarantee that you will be able to enjoy our products, Services and benefits if you elect not to disclose it to us. Overall, your final remedies will be to close this web tab, delete your account with us and/or exit the Website.

Purpose And Process Of The Collected Information

In order for us to offer our products and provide our Services, we will need to undertake the storage, use, combination, integration, disclosure, and process of your PI; including, in case, the transfer to our affiliates and other authorized third parties. If you open an account, we will collect your username and your password and other information necessary in order to open and access it.

We will generally collect, use and disclose your PI to:

- Send recommendations about your browsing preferences.
- Verify your e-mail address; send password retrieval links and other account notices.
- Improve your user experience and provide you with personalized support.
- Develop, research, process, safeguard and improve our services.
- Answer to customer service queries and suggestions you submit to us.
- Improve your user experience, offer newsletters, promotions, surveys, send service related announcements and contact you about inquiries for our services.

Control Of Your Information

In order to enforce of your privacy rights, please contact us through email or through our Contact page.

Your privacy request must include, at the least, the following information:

(a) your complete name, address and/or e-mail address in order for us to notify you the response to your request;

(b) attached documents establishing your identity; and

(c) a clear and concise description of the PI with regard to which you seek to enforce any of your privacy rights. If you request rectification, please indicate amendments to be made and attach documentation to back up your request.

Upon receipt of your privacy request, and after due review, we may then edit, deactivate and/or delete your PI from our Website. Please take into account that we may not be able to delete all of your data from our secure databases or the databases of third parties to which your PI has already been disclosed. If that is the case, please contact such third parties directly in order to request enforcement of

your privacy rights. In case of secure databases under our control where deletion becomes impossible, we will make such information inaccessible.

Safety Of Your Information

We use industry standard protocols and technology to protect your registered user information and PI (e.g. Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and secure databases).



Your PI is only accessible by a limited number of people who have special access rights given by Szuperc Ltd.

Data that you register to our Website in order to be promoted on your profile page will be visible by anyone visiting your profile. Give and register data on your profile that you want to appear visibly.

SCC Member and SCC iPad app accounts require a username (email) and password to log in. You must keep your username and password secure, and never disclose it to a third party. Account passwords are encrypted, which means we cannot see your passwords. We cannot resend forgotten passwords either. We will only reset them what you can ask with "Forgotten password" on Login page.

We implement and maintain reasonable security measures to protect our databases and records from unauthorized access, acquisition, destruction, use, modification or disclosure. However, please take into consideration that the Internet and related transmissions are not secure or error free communication means.

Social Media

The Website may offer the functionality of using your social media and other third party credentials (e.g. Facebook and Google) to execute single-sign-on, and in that manner we will also collect your PI as provided to us by such third party platforms; such as your photos, info of your social media contacts and their common contacts, login data and profile information such as "about me", "friend lists" and "interests".

We will not collect more information when using such credentials beyond the PI such third parties generally disclose to us via their services. For more information, please refer to the terms and policies of such platforms.

Please take into consideration that if you post information on a public forum, message board, blog or bulletin board, any PI you elect to disclose therein there may or will be read, collected and/or used by other users of such forums and could be used by third parties to send you unsolicited messages.

Parental Notice

Through the simple use of the Website and our services, you hereby represent and warrant that you are at least eighteen (18) years of age –or older– as of the date of first access thereof. If you are still a minor (which may

depend on the jurisdiction where you reside), you must access our Website under the direct supervision of your parent or legal guardian.

We do not knowingly collect any kind of information from persons under the age of thirteen (13). If we learn or have reason to suspect that one of our users is under the age of thirteen (13), we will delete that account, along with any information thereof.

Information Release And Disclosure

We must reserve our right to disclose your PI when we or our affiliates, clients, contractors, licensors, officers, agents and/or representatives reasonably believe it necessary to protect our interests, or where you result to be in breach of Terms and/or this Policy. Accordingly, we will have the right to disclose any and all collected PI and/or data, under the following circumstances:

- If required under applicable law, rules or regulations (like when you purchase something from us)
- In response to a valid request or subpoena from a government or law enforcement agency.
- To defend ourselves and our affiliates, licensors, officers, agents and representatives from legal claims and processes brought to us by third parties (including takedown notices).
- To defend the property, rights and integrity of any of our users, advertisers or licensors.
- To stop or cause to cease any actions that we may consider to cause – whether allegedly or factually– a contingency or liability.

We may also share non-personal information with third parties, such as aggregate user statistics, demographic information, and web site usage information.

Newsletters and Commercial Messages

A CEM (Commercial Electronic Messages) is a message in an electronic format (e.g. email, SMS, push notifications and other form of communications) which is then sent to an electronic address (e.g. email, mobile device) and that contains a message asking recipients to participate in commercial activities (e.g. purchase of products, services and invitations to participate in user research).

Our optional email newsletters are considered CEMs, and handled by Mailchimp and/or Mailerlite (“**Email Providers**”). If you subscribe to our

newsletter on our website your PI (collected via embedded sign-up forms) will be transferred to and processed by those Email provider services.

Processing activities performed by our Email providers includes (but not limited to)

(a) collection (e.g., via sign-up forms) and storage of personal data (within our Email provider account in order to allow us to create and use distribution lists, send marketing email campaigns, and place online advertisements), and

(b) the transfer of personal data to Email providers' sub-processors.

Please take into consideration that we are not responsible for the privacy and personal data practices undertaken by the Email providers (including any tools, cookies, information or content contained thereunto), and that we do not have control over the manner in which they may collect, process, treat or use your PI.

The Email providers gives you the option to subscribe or unsubscribe from them at will, following the unsubscribe links contained in every email sent by us via our Email providers.

You can also update your information with the link provided in every email.

System Messages, Confirmation and Billing Emails

If you register to our Website or buy something, our system may send you automatic confirmation emails (invoices and other necessary information about your purchased item) and system messages from time to time. It happens with your consent with registration, so please do not register to our Website or buy anything from us if you don't wish to receive such emails.

Cookies And Beacons

From time to time, we may use and place the so-called 'cookies' in your computer in order to track and collect data regarding your use of our Website and our services. Cookies are small text files that our Website transfers to you and that allow us permit us to recognize you and obtain data such as how, when and how long you browse pages in our Website. We also use the so-called 'beacons', which are small files, sometimes only a pixel in size, embedded onto the pages of our Website. Beacons are used to identify each of our pages in order to be analyzed by our system tools. You can always configure your browser to refuse cookies and beacons. Please take into consideration that we are not responsible for the privacy and personal data practices undertaken by such third parties (including any tools, cookies, information or content contained thereunto), and that we do not have control over the manner in which such third-parties may collect, process, treat or use your PI.

When you use such links to go to another site, our Policy and Terms are no longer into effect and your browsing thereof is in your own and final risk. In addition, any banner or ad that we may have on our Website does not constitute any endorsement of any third party thereof.

Advertising, opt-out

From time to time, we may use ad tracking codes, and other third party software tools (such as remarketing codes) in order to collect information and marketing analytics about the manner in which you browse our Website. These ads served will be targeted based on your previous browsing history, and may include retargeting codes. For example, third party vendors may show you SCC.World's ads on certain sites across the Internet, even after you leave our Website. The collected information is anonymized, meaning it cannot be tracked back to individuals. Using such tools, we learn how to optimize, and serve ads based on a user's past visits, providing you with a better user experience.

Our third party vendors may also use cookies and beacons to track your Internet browsing in order to serve you ads based on what they or us believe to be of interest according to your browsing activities and consumer preferences. Henceforth, by using our Website, you consent to such disclosure, treatment and storage of PI.

We use third-party payment processors to manage any transactions undertaken through the Website. The processing of payments will be subject to the fees, terms, conditions and privacy policies of such payment processors. Szuperc Ltd. is not responsible for any and all fees, delays or errors by such payment processors.

International disclosure

Upon the case where Szuperc Ltd specifically undertakes the process of personal data that has been duly disclosed by you to us, by clicking the “I Accept” button or otherwise accepting the terms and conditions of our services through a clickable action or similar action, you hereby acknowledge, agree and accept to such transfer.

Amendments, Changes, Updates

We reserve the right to amend, change, suspend and/or update our Website, our services, this Policy and/or our Terms, in whole or in part, from time to time and at our sole and final discretion. Any such changes will be effective immediately upon being posted, unless otherwise stated.

Your continued use thereof after the last effective date of modifications thereof indicates your acceptance of such modifications. We will post any updates on our Website, and may also send you an email or otherwise notify you of any material changes to this Policy.
